Re: TENDER FOR AUDITING SERVICES

Pecan is a community charity established through local churches in 1989. The charity provides a range of community activities and services such as helping people into work, hosting Southwark Foodbank, supporting women as they leave prison and a community timebank. The charity is also established as a limited company and turns over approximately £600,000 - £700,000 per year.

It is good practice to tender for auditing services every 3-5 years. For Pecan this process is slightly delayed, hence now tendering for auditing services for the financial year April 2016 – March 2017.

Proposals need to be no longer than two sides of A4. Our criteria for shortlisting are;

- Suitably qualified auditors
- Experience of working with charities of a similar size to Pecan
- Explanation of Pecan's responsibilities under SORP
- Structure of audit and recommendations for independent examination or full audit
- Cost of the audit and submission to the Charity Commission and Companies House
- Availability for occasional advice during the year
- Ability to complete the audit by July 2017

When appointed it is our intention to re-tender after 3 years.

Tenders need to be emailed to Sylvie Bissileu Finance and Operations Manager Sylvie.bissileu@pecan.org.uk by 3pm on Monday 22nd May Interviews for prospective auditors will take place at Pecan on Tuesday 30th May.
